Take tram **No. 6** (direction Zoo) to **ETH/Universitätsspital** or **Platte** or **No. 10** (direction Zürich Flughafen) to **ETH/Universitätsspital**
- From **Bellevue**:
Take tram **No. 9** (direction Hirzenbach) to **Kantonsschule** or **ETH/Universitätsspital** or tram **No. 5** (direction Kirche Fluntern) to **Kantonsschule** or **Platte**
- From **Zurich Airport**:
Take tram **No. 10** (direction Zürich HB) to **ETH/Universitätsspital**
